

# **ADULT WINTER HANDGUN LEAGUES**

December 7, 2018 thru April 19, 2019

Red River Regional Marksmanship Center is organizing an Adult All Skill Level Winter Handgun Shooting League beginning December 7, 2018 and ending April 19, 2019. There are two Divisions and shooters can participate in one or both divisions.

## **DIVISION 1 .22 RIMFIRE HANDGUN**

Any legal .22 Rimfire Handgun that falls within RRRMC Guidelines are allowed. Course of fire will be standing (offhand) with three 10 shot relays – shot at distances of 10 feet, 20 feet and 50 feet. Open sights, Red Dot Optics, Lasers and Scopes are allowed. You will be allowed 3 minutes for each relay. A countdown timer will be used during these events.

## **DIVISION 2 CENTERFIRE HANDGUN**

Any legal Center Fire Handgun that falls within RRRMC Guidelines are allowed. Course of fire will be standing (offhand) with three 10 shot relays shot at distances of 10 feet, 20 feet and 50 feet. Open sights, Red Dot Optics, Lasers and Scopes are allowed. You will be allowed 3 minutes for each relay. A countdown timer will be used during these events.

### **ALL RRRMC SAFETY RULES AND CODES OF CONDUCT APPLY TO ALL EVENTS ADDITIONAL SPECIFIC RULES WILL ALSO APPLY**

The 10 scheduled League Matches will be on Friday evenings on the specified dates, however make-up shoots and pre-shoots can be done during open shooting at the shooters convenience.

#### **Cost:**

- \$20 League fee for all 10 matches per Division for RRRMC Premium Members
- \$20 League fee for all 10 matches per Division for RRRMC Standard Members plus \$5 fee per match
- \$20 League fee for all 10 matches per Division for Non-Members League Shooters plus a \$15 fee per match

## **WINTER HANDGUN LEAGUE RULES**

- All participants must have a current RRRMC liability waiver on file
- No drawing from holsters, unloaded guns will be placed on station shooting shelf, muzzle downrange. Upon load and make ready command, guns will be loaded, and shooter will prepare to shoot. A shoot command will be given and shooting then begins. After 3 minutes a cease fire command will be given. All shooting must immediately stop, guns made safe and laid on shooting shelf muzzle downrange.
- Revolvers and other guns which have less than a 10-round capacity may be reloaded at will once shooting command is given.
- 10 shots per target only. Any additional shots will be deducted at highest possible value from score.
- Best edge scoring will be used; if you just hit outside edge of the 10 ring you will be awarded 10 points.
- If there is a tie for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place the last match of the season there is a tie breaker rule. Shooter with the smallest group on the last target (measured center to center) will win the tie.
- All 10 league matches must be completed by April 19, 2019.
- Make-up matches, and pre-shoots will be done during normal open shooting times under the direction of the on-duty Range Safety Officer.
- Targets used will be NRA Official Competition 25 yd. slow-fire pistol target B-16.
- In the case of a malfunction the competitor may change guns with permission of the RSO.

**ALL RRRMC SHOOTING RULES WILL APPLY DURING LEAGUE MATCHES**
